Did I Pass?



Scores are usually available within a few days from computer-based tests, and can take up to two weeks for paper-based tests.

GED® Passing Scores: You must score at least 145 on each of the subject area tests. Check your scores at MyGED.com

HiSET® Passing Scores: You must score at least 8 on each of the subject area tests, including a minimum of 2 points on the essay portion of the Writing test. An overall cumulative score of 45 or higher is required. Check your scores at HiSET.ets.org/MyHiSET

TASC® Passing Scores: You must score at least 500 on each of the subject area tests, including a minimum of 2 points on the essay portion of the Writing test. Check your scores at Nevada.TASCtest.com

Many people do not pass all of the subject areas on the first try. Retesting on failed subjects is available at discounted rates. Inquire at your testing center about retest fees and study options.

Documents



Upon successful completion and passing of a High School Equivalency exam, test-takers in Nevada receive an official transcript and a Nevada Certificate of High School Equivalency.

The initial transcript and certificate are provided free of charge and are mailed to the address provided at test registration. The documents are sent automatically, no action on your part is required.

Nevada and many other states are using the HiSET® Test or the TASC™ Test in addition to the GED® Test as approved assessments for High School Equivalency. If you earned your HSE Certificate by passing either the HiSET® or TASC™ tests, you may be asked if you have a GED®. The answer is:
